The New Hampshire legislature in 1993 enacted RSA 458-D, establishing a pilot project to offer the Child Impact

Program. Initially offered in four counties, the program has expanded statewide. NH Community Behavioral Health Association (NHCBHA) coordinates the Child Impact Program in all ten NH counties. NHCBHA works closely with the NH Judicial Branch to help parents, kids and the courts in providing information regarding the impact of divorce and separation on children.
